LIVE MUSIC

Wednesday 17th November: Anton Browne

Singer, pianist and percussionist Anton has been a regular on the London jazz scene for many years. His appearances range from sell-out gigs at Ronnie Scott's, to singing on TV's Top Of The Pops and Wogan. A former vocal coach on The Voice, he is a long-time teacher at The BRIT School, has been Professor of Jazz Voice at Trinity Music College and is a former Musical Director of Bateaux London Cruises.

Thursday 18th November: Ellie Laine and Roger Lewin

Ellie - summed up by one radio presenter as "a lovely voice and bags of personality" - appears regularly at jazz venues in London and the South. She was among singers invited to perform on Simon Cowell's Grenfell Tower charity single Bridge Over Troubled Water, which went to No1 in 14 countries. Pianist Roger has been a regular feature at top London hotels including The Savoy, The Dorchester and Claridge's and has played with pop artists including Boney M and Hot Chocolate.

Friday 19th November: Christian Vaughan and Amanda Forbes

Singer Amanda moved to London from Australia in 2004 to take up a scholarship at the Royal Academy of Music. She worked for many years in the classical and operatic world - singing at the Royal Opera House - before turning her attention to jazz, rock, folk and popular music. Pianist and composer Christian trained at the Royal Academy of Music and is a former TV musical director as well as being a seasoned performer on the jazz scene.

Saturday 20th November: Shireen Francis and Gunther Kurmayr

Shireen has been described as a cross between Ella Fitzgerald, Aretha Franklin and Shirley Bassey. She never fails to impress -even when her audience includes soul superstar Lionel Richie. The American Idol judge made a point of telling her afterwards: "You sound wonderful." Inspired by artists such as Ella, Sarah Vaughan, Gladys Knight and Dinah Washington, Shireen performs swinging jazz, Latin, old-school soul and soulful blues. She is joined by her accompanist of many years, Austrian pianist Gunther.
